## TO ALL CAMP COUNSELOR/HOUSE PARENT PROSPECTS,

**Thank you for your interest in being a counselor/house parent at Camp "Destiny"!** The counselors and house parents play a major role in keeping the campers safe, happy and inspired! The duties are important. This is a job to be taken very seriously.

During **sessions 1- 4**, the counselors for THEATRE MAJORS will have an opportunity to exercise their directing skills while assisting their group with a scene study presentation; counselors for "ON CAMERA"/VIDEO MAJORS will help write & direct a video project; counselors for MUSICAL THEATRE MAJORS will assist in the production of a staged musical theatre piece.

Counselors often work in pairs and are in charge of 8-10 students. It is the counselor's responsibility to see that the students get to all classes, meals, activities and bed ON TIME. After the students are in class, the counselors are free to leave for their own classes (We will sometimes ask counselors to attend certain large classes with the campers to assist the instructors).

House parents need to be multi-skilled, multi-talented, jacks-of-all-trades who are flexible enough to handle a variety of organizational tasks. You will be in charge of the dorm" acting as the mom/dad for the week. Your main job will be performed in the evenings as everyone heads back to the dorm to wind down. The counselors have their meetings and 'free time' from 10pm-1am, and it is at that time that your job is most crucial. During daylight hours, you will be recruited to do various things and can take some classes or a nap yourselves!

Counselors and House Parents have a great deal of influence over the campers; therefore, it is imperative that our personnel have a positive attitude & impeccable behavior and morals (This means **NO DRUGS, NO SEX, NO SMOKING, NO ALCOHOL, NO FOWL LANGUAGE, NO ANYTHING YOU WOULDN'T DO OR SAY IN FRONT OF YOUR MOM, A NUN, OR THE CAMP DIRECTOR!!!** Counselors and staff must have LOTS OF SMILES, ENERGY, CREATIVITY, ENCOURAGEMENT, DIPLOMACY, ENTHUSIASM, & GIGGLES.) In addition to this, **counselors must be able to respect the authority of the camp staff members who are their employers.** So, we are looking for people that are positive, talented, and responsible.
