Counselor/House Parent Benefits:

1. Attend classes in Contemporary, Classical and Improvisational Theatre; Commercial, Film & Television Acting; Audition Techniques; Musical Theatre; Stage Combat; Mime; Juggling; Clowning, Stage Movement, Dance (Jazz, Tap, Lyrical, African, Swing, Nostalgic, Hip Hop, Latin & Rhythm Dancing) Choreography & Acrobatics.
 2. Opportunity to audition for Casting Directors & Agents in the TV/Film Industry. Each performer receives individual feedback from each casting professional. The audition process is designed as a learning experience, yet it has resulted in many performers gaining agent representation & being cast in TV/Film projects, Commercials & Theatrical Productions.

Counselor duties:

1. Be responsible for a group of 8-10 students between the ages of 8-18. (Guide their class choices, keep them safe, happy & inspired)
2. Act as Director for a group project in theatre, video or musical theatre to be presented to an audience.
3. Assist with set up, break-down and clean up as needed, including the day before & day after camp.
4. Attend a MANDATORY Counselor/Staff seminar for preparation and recreation on June 3rd for Day camp staff & July 10th-12th for Residential staff. (Adult staff are only required to attend 11-4pm July 11)

House Parent responsibilities:

1. House parents need to be multi-skilled, multi-talented, jacks-of-all-trades who are flexible enough to handle a variety of organizational tasks. You will be in charge of the dorm, acting as the 'mom/dad' for the week. Your main job will be performed in the evenings as everyone heads back to the dorm to wind down. The counselors have their meetings and 'free time' from 10pm-1am, and it is at that time that your job is most crucial. During daylight hours, you will be recruited to do various things and can take some classes or a nap yourselves!
 2. Assist with special events such as the "Unolympics" and check-in & check-out procedures.
 3. Attend a MANDATORY Counselor/Staff seminar for preparation and recreation 11-4pm July 11th.
